

Biosintex inaugurates a new plant of medicinal lozenges

This way, Biosintex will have two plants, since it maintains the original Barracas, to elaborate liquids and semisolids, at the moment it is in process of extension and modernization of equipment and technology.

Biosintex has had a constant and sustained growth since its inception. The company sales in the last four years grew at a rate significantly higher than the industry average. A successful policy of development and launch of new products contributed to the progressive growth of the company.
